ORDINANCE NO. 1084-15

A CAPITAL ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 1057-13, APPROPRIATING AN ADDITIONAL \$95,000 FOR THE MAKING OF VARIOUS IMPROVEMENTS AND THE ACQUISITION OF VARIOUS EQUIPMENT AND VEHICLES BY THE BOROUGH OF OLD TAPPAN AND TO APPROPRIATE AN ADDITIONAL \$75,000 FROM A FEMA GRANT AND \$20,000 FROM RESERVE FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Governing Body of the Borough of Old Tappan in the County of Bergen, New Jersey (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) as follows:

SECTION 1. Capital ordinance 1057-13 of the Borough of Old Tappan, New Jersey adopted by the governing body thereof on April 1, 2013, is hereby amended to the extent and with the effect that Section 1, Section 2(F), Section 2 (Total Ordinance), Section 3(b) and Section 5 thereof shall read as follows (changed text is underscored):

SECTION 1. The improvement described in Section 2 of this Ordinance is hereby respectively authorized as a general improvement to be made by the Borough of Old Tappan, New Jersey, for the said improvements or purposes stated in Section 2, there are hereby appropriated the sum of money therein stated as the appropriation made for said improvement or purpose, said sum being inclusive of all appropriations heretofore made thereof and amounting in the aggregate to \$517,500 which is now available in the amount of \$100,000 from General Capital Surplus, \$279,000 from the Capital Improvement Fund, \$16,500 from the Reserve for Sidewalk Improvements, \$47,000 from the Reserve for Capital Improvements and \$75,000 from a Federal Emergency Management Grant.

SECTION 3. (b) It is not necessary to finance said appropriation by the issuance of obligations by the Borough of Old Tappan pursuant to the Local Bond Law of the State of New Jersey, for the reason that monies sufficient to cover the appropriation thereof shall be available from General Capital Surplus in the amount of \$100,000, from the Capital Improvement Fund in the amount of \$279,000, from the Reserve for Sidewalk Improvements of \$16,500, the Reserve for Capital Improvements of \$47,000 and \$75,000 from a Federal Emergency Management Grant.

SECTION 5. The sum of \$517,500 is hereby appropriated for the aforementioned purposes.

SECTION 2. The Capital Budget of the Borough of Old Tappan is hereby amended or established to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. The resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing all detail of the amended or temporary Capital Budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Clerk and is available for public inspection.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect after publication thereof and final passage as required by law.
