Earlier in March the Council unanimously introduced a Resolution opposing NJ Assembly Bill A4 and Senate Bill S50 aimed to overhaul the Affordable Housing legislation throughout New Jersey. Your governing body supports Affordable Housing opportunities, however, there were a number of deficiencies in this legislation which, if passed, would place an undue burden on our municipality. I, along with my Pascack and Northern Valley Mayor counterparts, also personally drafted an email to all 40 State Senators and 80 Assembly members, asking to table this bill until more discussion could be had. Unfortunately, Governor Murphy signed this legislation into law on March 20th. Your Council, our Planning professionals and I will work tirelessly to submit a plan that works for Old Tappan while adhering to this irresponsible legislation.

In closing, I want to thank again, all our volunteers, board members, coaches, library staff and residents for all you do for Old Tappan.
