

**BOROUGH OF OLD TAPPAN
ORDINANCE NO. 1160-20**

**AN ORDINANCE SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 119, "FEES" OF THE
CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF OLD TAPPAN TO AMEND THE FEES
CHARGED FOR USE OF THE OLD TAPPAN GOLF COURSE**

WHEREAS, the Golf Commission has recommended to the Mayor and Council that the fees charged for use of the municipal golf course be amended;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council has determined that the golf course fees should be amended as set forth herein;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Old Tappan, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. ARTICLE II, Golf Course Fees of Chapter 119, "Fees" of the Code of the Borough of Old Tappan is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced by the following:

119-8. Fees, rents and other charges.

Fees are not refundable. Full payment must be paid on or before March 1. The following are the fees, rents and other charges for admission to and use of the Old Tappan Golf Course for the 2020 season:

A. NON-RESIDENT

Juniors, ages 12 to 22 (restricted to 18 holes of golf per day; may not play before 3:30 p.m. on weekends, holidays and Tuesdays)	\$ 800.00

Juniors, ages 8 to 11 (restricted to 18 holes of golf per day; must be accompanied by an adult who is a paid member; may not play before 3:30 p.m. on weekends, holidays and Tuesdays)	\$ 800.00

College Student (June-August only)	\$ 300.00

Section 2. Repealer.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to said inconsistencies and conflicts.

Section 3. Severability

If any section, part of any section, or clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the remaining provisions of this ordinance. The governing body of the Borough of Old Tappan declares that it would have passed the ordinance and each section thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more of the subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases may be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

Section 4. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall take immediate effect upon passage and publication according to law.
