


A Message from Mayor John M. Kramer

It seems as though spring is late in arriving. But as we await its arrival, please allow me to bring you up to date on a few matters.

- Our 2018 road repaving program is currently out for bid. State D.O.T. Funds @ \$400,000. Borough funds @ \$500,000.
- The 2018 municipal budget has been adopted. Budget calls for a \$59.00 per year increase on the average home assessment of \$825,000. School and county tax increases, if any, are not included.
- NJ Superior Court conducted a Fairness Hearing on February 15th and approved our Affordable Housing Plan. We are now protected from the "builders remedy" through 2025.
- LANDSCAPERS ORDINANCE now in effect. Hours of operation: Monday –
 Friday 8:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. Saturday 8am to 5:00pm Sunday Prohibited. Please advise your landscape contractor of these hours of operation.

OLD TAPPAN FIRST AID CORPS YEAR IN REVIEW...



In 2017, the OTFAC responded to 352 calls for service. In addition to responding to calls in OT, the OTFAC also routinely responds mutual aid to neighboring communities. In total, Corps members provided over 17,000 hours of volunteer service - all at no cost to the residents. We welcomed 3 new EMT's - Lauren DiPalo, Victoria Walker and Christina Zara. All three completed extensive

training at the Bergen County EMS Academy in Paramus and recently passed their state exams. Congratulations to Corpsman of the Year, EMT Rich Apramian. EMT Apramian served as Lieutenant in 2017, responsible for recruiting, supplies, and training. Rich responded to over 100 calls during the year and volunteered over 800 hours of his time to serving the community. We would also like to thank all of the residents for contributing to our successful 2017 fund drive. The OTFAC is a non-profit, all-volunteer organization, and never charges for emergency response. As a non-profit, the Corps depends on financial support from Borough residents and business owners. Each year, when you receive our fund drive letter, we encourage you to consider the "what -ifs." Perhaps you've never needed to call 911 and request the services of the OTFAC. And although we hope you never have to, we are here for the "whatifs." No one ever calls for an ambulance when they are having a great day - we usually only get called when residents are having a really bad day. When we roll out the door of the squad building, our goal is to make our patients feel better. providing top notch care and true compassion. And if you experience one of those really bad days, we want to ensure we will be there for you too. New Members & EMTs are also a much needed resource. Important Information For the 2017 Election from the Office of the Borough Clerk

PRIMARY ELECTION: Tuesday, June 5th 6am - 8pm

Last day to register to vote in the Primary Election is Tue., May 15th. The Municipal Clerk's office will remain open on Tue., May 15th until 9pm

GENERAL ELECTION: Tuesday, Nov. 6th 6 am - 8 pm

Last day to register to vote in the General Election is Tue., October 16th. Municipal Clerk's office will remain open on Tue., Oct. 16th until 9 pm.

The Bergen County Board of Elections issues voter Registration Cards.

If you are going to be out of town on Election Day, you may pick up an absentee ballot application at the Borough Clerk's Office. The <u>County Clerk</u> must receive applications by mail no later than 7 days prior to Election Day. <u>After the 7 day deadline all applications must be hand delivered to the County Clerk no later then 3pm the day before the election.</u>

DISTRICTS AND POLLING PLACES: Watch for your Sample Ballot, which indicates your District and Polling Place in the left hand corner. Contact the Municipal Clerks office at 201-664-1849 ext. 14 if you have any questions.

Property Taxes:

Due date 5/1/18. There is a 10 day grace period until 5/10/18.

Do we have your correct mailing address: Many tax bills as well as other important notices from the Tax Collector are returned by the Post Office as undeliverable. Property owners often neglect advising our office that their mailing address has changed. Please help us keep our records up to date. Requests to change mailing address must be submitted in writing. Look for the Property Record Change form on www.oldtappan.net.

Online bill pay from your bank: Please be aware payments that you initiate with your own bank through online bill pay should be scheduled in advance of any due date to allow a sufficient number of mailing days for the Borough to receive, process and apply the payment to your account. Payments from online bill pay are sent through the mail. We do not accept electronic payment for taxes. All payments must be received by 4PM on the 10th day of the grace period. The Borough is not responsible for late payments due to delays in mail service or bank processing. PLEASE INCLUDE YOUR BLOCK AND LOT, LAST NAME AND/OR PROPERTY ADDRESS in order for us to apply the payment to the correct account.


Pay with Direct Withdrawal: An alternative to online bill pay is the Direct Withdrawal ACH bank draft program we have in place for both taxes and sewer flow fees. Please check our website for application forms and details or come in person to get an application.

Borough mailbox: On the front of the Borough hall for your convenience there is a mailbox to drop payments in when Borough hall is closed. All payments will be posted the following day. Do not use mailbox for regular mail.



THE 2018 MEMORIAL DAY PARADE will be held MEMORIAL DAY ROUTE

on Monday, May, 28th. The Parade will step off from the back of Northern Valley Old Tappan High School promptly at 9:30 am. The parade ends with the participating organizations assembling in front of the memorials in Oakes Park on Central Avenue. The Memorial Ceremony includes parading the colors, the National Anthem, the Invocation, address by the Mayor, placing wreaths at the Memorial, the rifle salute and taps. In the event of inclement weather, the Fire Department siren will be sounded at 8:15 a.m. to advise that the Parade is canceled. In that event, the Memorial Day Ceremony will be held in the Charles DeWolf School Gym at 9:30 a.m. Wreaths will then be placed at the Memorial by representatives of each organization making a presentation, after which taps will be played. We ask you to remind members of your organization, children and adults alike, that Memorial Day is a solemn occasion, dedicated to the memory of our countrymen who have given their lives so that we may enjoy our freedom. Let us treat their memory with dignity and respect, along the Parade route as well as during Memorial Services.
