ABANDONED / VACANT LOT REGISTRY

Councilman Binaghi advised that a draft ordinance pertaining to property abandoned during construction was distributed for discussion. COUNCIL COMMITTEE REPORTS AND REVIEW OF CORRESPONDENCE

COUNCILMAN BINAGHI - DPW / CONSTRUCTION

The DPW is backed up on leaf removal due to the recent snow fall. The DPW Superintendent will be discussing new hires due to upcoming retirements. The Building Inspector is looking to discuss budget items for next year.

COUNCILMAN CIOCE - ENVIRONMENTAL / LIBRARY / HISTORICAL

The library closed early due to the weather conditions. Environmental Commission is discussing tree seedlings and will further discuss at their next meeting.

COUNCILMAN YHU – SAFETY / SENIORS / AFFORDABLE HOUSING

Met with the Senior Advisory Committee on November 21st. They will host their holiday luncheon on December 12th. All members whose terms are up will be reappointed. Our

social service director will be retiring. Councilman Yhu attended the League of Municipalities and took some classes while there. He will be looking to take some continuing education classes. We are looking into expanding the Mayor's Wellness Program. Councilman Yhu attended an Affordable Housing seminar.

COUNCILMAN GALLAGHER – PLANNING / ARTS & ENTERTAINMENT / FIRST AID

The Planning Board will meet on December 11th at 7:00 p.m. to continue discussion on the Pearson application. The First Aid Corps selected their new line officers for 2020 and will begin working on their budget. The Fire Department is holding their annual officer's dinner this evening and gear check. The Fire Chief will implement the Blue Light Safety and Protocol program. Fit tests will be done tomorrow evening for all fire fighters to insure proper fitness of their masks. Councilman Gallagher reviewed the Fire Department's November activity report. Santa Claus will visit Old Tappan on December 22nd. The Ambulance Corps dinner is this Saturday.
