Site work at the Enclave, residential/business construction site east of Bi-State Plaza, continues with several models open for your inspection. The parcel opposite the Northern Valley Regional High School has been cleared of its' three vacant homes making way for the 26 condominium unit planned for. The Planning Board is, or will soon be, considering an application for a senior assisted living facility on Old Tappan Road adjacent to the Malankara Archdioceses of the Syrian Orthodox Church. Unfortunately, the Bi-State Plaza "Foodtown" store remains vacant as do several stores within the site speculation abounds as to its' future.



After a number of loss revenue years, save for the last two, the Old Tappan Municipal Golf Course, beginning this season, will be run by a professionally managed company. The pending retirement of two longtime key employees, the expiration

of the concessionaire's five year contract, and the expiration of the three year golf cart contract brought us to hiring KemperSports, a nationally recognized golf management company. We look forward to a more profitable operation that will serve the

golfing community to a greater degree.



**PROPERTY TAXES:** Due date 2/1/22. There is a 10 day grace period until 2/10/22.

**SEWER USER FEE: Due date 3/1/22.** There is a 10-day grace period until **3/10/22**. Bills are mailed out at the end of January for the first HALF of the year. If you are 65 years old or older you may apply to get a discounted rate. Application form is

also available at the Tax Office or on the Borough's website. Once applied no need to apply

#### **ONLINE PAYMENT OPTIONS FOR TAXES & SEWER:**

BILL PAY FROM YOUR BANK: Payments should be scheduled in advance of due date to allow sufficient mailing days for the Borough to receive, process and apply the payment. Electronic payment for taxes are not accepted. Payments must be received by 4pm on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the grace period. The Borough is not responsible for late payments due to delays in mail service or bank processing. IMPORTANT: INCLUDE YOUR BLOCK AND LOT, LAST NAME AND/OR PROPERTY **ADDRESS** so that your payment is applied to the correct account.

ONLINE BILL PAY: www.edmundsgovpay.com/oldtappan is convenient and easy, 24/7 access, to view account information and securely pay online. Accepted payment methods are credit card, debit card or eCheck (please note fees are charged.) Link is on the home page of our website.

PAY WITH DIRECT WITHDRAWAL: ACH bank draft program is in place for both taxes and sewer flow fees. Please visit our website for application forms and details or visit us in person. If you are planning to sign-up, discontinue or make a change on your direct withdrawal, you must contact our office at least two weeks before the effective date of scheduled withdrawal.

POST-DATED CHECKS: According to NJ Statute, our office is required to deposit payments as soon as they are received and we cannot accept "post-dated" checks. Therefore, please date your check the day you write it out, just as you would if you were paying in person.

BOROUGH MAILBOX: Located in front of the Borough Hall for your convenience when Borough Hall is closed. All payments are posted the following day. Do not use mailbox for regular mail.

Annual Property Tax Deduction for Senior Citizens, Disabled Persons: Annual deduction of up to \$250 from property taxes for homeowners 65 or older or disabled who meet certain income and residency requirements. This benefit is administered by the local municipality.

Annual Deduction for Veterans: Annual deduction of up to \$250 from property taxes due for Veterans with full-time active service and proofs (form dd-214) showing honorable discharge from the military. This deduction is also available to a surviving spouse/civil union/domestic partner who has not remarried. This benefit is administered by the local municipality and audited by the New Jersey Division of Taxation.

Property Tax Exemption for Disabled Veterans: Full exemption from property taxes on a principal residence for Veterans classified as totally and permanently disabled by the Veterans Association as a result of their active & full-time military service. This exemption is also available to a surviving spouse/civil union/domestic partner who has not remarried. This application requires the disability certification letter from the VA and must state that the veterans qualifying affliction was 100% disabling as well as permanent. This benefit is administered by the local municipality and audited by the New Jersey Division of Taxation.

**Building Department:** Please note that the Building Department now has a separate entrance on the side of the Borough Hall. Hours are from 8:30am-4pm Monday through Friday. Should you need any information, please do not hesitate to email taco@oldtappan.net or call 201-664-1849 ext 19.

#### **DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS NEWS:**

SEWER: Residents are reminded to dispose of grease properly by putting it out with your garbage. Pouring grease down your drain clogs your pipes and the sewer pipes in the streets. Residents are also reminded to discard Swiffer type

fibrous cleaning products with your garbage and not to flush them. Also, residents are reminded that sump pumps are not allowed to be piped into your sanitary sewer line.

**RECYCLING:** The recycling center is opened Mon. through Fri., 7am to 3pm, and from 9am to 1pm on Saturdays (except holidays). Please bring only those items designated for recycling and place them in the appropriate designated container. Do not place plastic bags in with your items. Please use the curbside pickup whenever possible to prevent an overflow situation at the DPW yard. Effective 2011 consumer electronics may not be disposed of in the trash. We do not accept garbage, construction debris, paint or chemicals, fluorescent bulbs etc. Violators will be prosecuted. Questions as to what is acceptable or where you may dispose, please call 201-664-4438.

PARKING PROHIBITION: Please remember that there is no overnight parking on any Borough street until April 1st. Also, whenever snow has fallen and the accumulation is such that it covers the roadway, an emergency shall exist and no vehicles shall be parked on any Borough street, road, highway, right-of-way or thoroughfare. Any unoccupied vehicle parked or standing in violation shall be deemed a nuisance and a menace to the safe and proper regulation of traffic and any Police Officer may provide for the removal of such vehicle. The owner shall pay the reasonable costs of the removal and storage which may result from such removal before regaining possession of the vehicle.
