BOROUGH OF OLD TAPPAN ORDINANCE 1172-20

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND Chapter 242 of the Code of the Borough of Old Tappan titled "Vehicles and Traffic."

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Old Tappan as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> Chapter 242 of the Code of the Borough of Old Tappan, titled "Vehicles and Traffic", is hereby amended by adding a new section 242-24, to read as follows:

§242-24 - Temporary Parking Prohibition for Snow Plowing and Snow Removal.

- 1. Whenever snow has fallen and the accumulation is such that it covers the roadway, an emergency shall exist and no vehicles shall be parked on any Borough street, road, highway, right-of-way or thoroughfare except in conformity with this ordinance.
- 2. Except as permitted pursuant to these regulations, no vehicle shall be parked or left unattended on any street, right-of-way or thoroughfare, until the street, road, highway, right-of-way or thoroughfare has been plowed.
- 3. Any unoccupied vehicle parked or standing in violation of this subsection shall be deemed a nuisance and a menace to the safe and proper regulation of traffic and any Police Officer may provide for the removal of such vehicle. The owner shall pay the reasonable costs of the removal and storage which may result from such removal before regaining possession of the vehicle.
- 4. Unless some other penalty is expressly provided by New Jersey statute, every person convicted of a violation of this subsection or any supplement thereto, shall be liable to a penalty of not more than two hundred (\$200.00) dollars.
- <u>Section 2.</u> If any part of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance.
- <u>Section 3.</u> All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended to the extent of such inconsistency.
- <u>Section 4.</u> This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.
